Re: Directive 2002/95/EC on restriction on the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS)

Hereby Corus Special Strip Warren declares that all the steel products currently produced for your orders are in conformity with the requirements on the RoHS directive 2002/95/EC regarding lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium coming into force under the strict conditions:

1. That the proposed amendment (OJ L 37) by the Commission of the Annex according to article 5(1)(a) of Directive 2002/95/EC will be implemented. The proposed limit values are a "maximum concentration value of 0.1% by weight in homogeneous materials for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) and 0.01% weight in homogenous materials shall be tolerated."
2. That the product is not ordered with specifications not fulfilling the Annex of Directive 2000/53/EC concerning lead, mercury, cadmium, or hexavalent chromium.
