Wieland Rolled Products North America, LLC (Wieland) has determined that our products manufactured in the Waterbury, Connecticut facility comply with the requirements of the following European Union regulations/directives:

- Restriction on the Use of Hazardous Substance Directive 2015/863/EU (RoHS 3)
- End of Life Vehicle (ELV) Directive
- Global Automotive Declarable Substance List (GADSL)

Wieland products (except for Alloy 353) do not contain any of the two hundred and nineteen (219) substances in the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) Candidate List or don't contain Candidate List substances at or above the corresponding weight concentration limit. Alloy 353 exceeds the SVHC threshold for lead. The Candidate List was most recently updated on July 8, 2021 for authorization under the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemical Substances (REACH) Regulation. Wieland has also determined that the strip products we sell are "articles" under REACH and therefore exempt from any registration requirement.

Wieland products also do not contain nor are the following chemicals used as part of the manufacturing of our products: Bis phthalate (2-ethylhexyl) (DEHP), Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP), Butyl Benzyl Phthalate (BBP), and Perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA).

In addition to this, Wieland participates in the International Material Data System (IMDS), a tool to aid in compliance with the ELV.

This representation applies only to products as they are sold by Wieland. Each importer into the European Union should make its own determination as to whether products manufactured from or otherwise incorporating products sold by Wieland continue to comply with these Directives and Regulations.
